What is Geocaching?

Geocaching is a global treasure hunt in which participants use Global Positioning System (GPS) receivers to find geocaches hidden throughout the world. Caches can be as small as a dime or as large as a military ammo can. Some caches are not even physical caches, but events or significant landmarks. When geocachers find a cache, they will usually log their visit in a log book found in the cache. They may also trade trinkets, or swag, in the caches. Currently, there are about 1.7 million geocaches located in more than 150 countries around the world.

What is the Duke Farms GeoTrail?

The Duke Farms GeoTrail is a geocaching trail consisting of 11 different caches placed around the scenic Duke Farms property. Along the Geotrail, visitors will encounter native meadows, woodlands, lakes and waterfalls, statues and historic structures.
