

Community Garden Participation Agreement

2021 Season

Gardeners are required to fulfill the following obligations annually in order to maintain membership in the Community Garden:

1. **EMAIL:** Maintain a valid email address. This will be the primary form of communication between staff and gardeners. We also strongly recommend joining the Community Garden Facebook page. Any changes in email are to be reported within 3 business days.
2. **CONTINUING EDUCATION:** Attend 1 environmental course of your choice through Duke Farms or another suitable vendor. Record title in your *Online Garden Profile* on the Community Garden webpage in order to receive credit. **NOTE:** First year gardeners must complete 3 courses total: Orientation, Intro to Organic Gardening and 1 elective.
3. **VOLUNTEER:** Complete 4 hours of volunteer time at Duke Farms for your first garden plot, plus 1 hour for each additional plot. Record hours in your *Online Garden Profile* on the Community Garden webpage in order to receive credit.
4. **MAINTENANCE:** Comply with all maintenance expectation listed in the Duke Farms Community Garden Handbook. Surveys will be done weekly between April 15 and October 31. If a gardener receives a notice, they must address this issue within one week.
5. **CODE OF CONDUCT:** Please be courteous in the garden at all times. You are expected to review all safety, security and conduct expectations as stated in the Duke Farms Community Garden Handbook.
